5. Fundraising going forward

Mrs. Sharpe announced that Mr. Pochin has very kindly given us another garden to use in return for a posey of flowers (to be grown in the garden). It will need some work to get it up to scratch and so he has also kindly offered the services of his gardener. We will, however, still need a lot of volunteers/helpers to make it a wonderful space for the children to not only plant and grow, but a wonderful space to play! This will require a lot of funding and so this year we are going to set a fundraising target specifically for this purpose. To help us along, Mr. Pochin has made an amazing gesture and has offered to match our garden fundraising pound for pound! We are setting the fundraising target at £20,000 (including Mr. Pochin's donation). This may seem like a huge amount but we are already off to a great start as a parent at the school has donated a whopping £2,500 to start us off!! This is a very generous donation and we thank them sincerely!

With regard to ways to raise this money, we have had some wonderful suggestions from parents. These include:

- Sponsored virtual walks
- Recipe book where parents and children send in their favourite recipes to be made into a book. This can then be sold to raise money.
- Take-away school dinners where parents can buy school dinners to take home.
- Decorate a wooden spoon for Halloween.
- Non-uniform days

- Quizzes
- Raffles

It was decided that we would proceed immediately with non-uniform day (02/10/20), decorate a Halloween spoon (30/10/20). Recipe book, take-away dinners, quizzes and raffles to be discussed in more detail and then actioned. Mrs. Sharpe suggested that maybe the sponsored events could be incorporated into The Pochin Challenge that the children will be taking part in at school and maybe incorporate Burrough Hill, Rutland Water and Bradgate Park (Old John). To be discussed further.

We will also be setting up a charity eBay shop to sell donated items. Julie will look into setting up the Paypal account for this.

Textile bank - as we were were unable to proceed with Jimmy Joe's last year we have managed to arrange for a textile bank to be delivered for us to use all year round. As space is so limited at school, Thorpe Farm/Roots have kindly allowed us to site it in their carpark. This is fantastic news as this can be used by school parents as well as members of the public. In return, they will pay us £400 per tonne (40p per Kilo). This will hopefully generate us a continuous income. Ria kindly offered to monitor it and inform Louise when it needs emptying.

Some really fantastic things to organise and look forward to!
