

Art

The curriculum is designed and taught as a spiral curriculum: pupils return to the same skills again and again during their time in primary school, each time a skill is revisited it is covered with greater complexity, upon returning to a skill, prior knowledge is utilised so pupils can build upon previous foundations, rather than starting again.

Within each year (except year 6) there are two formal units where pupils are discretely taught art, craft and design skills. These are then developed through the application in another unit and also in opportunities throughout the themed curriculum. *A child that is in EYFS will have the opportunity to revisit the discrete skills taught in that cycle in year 2 and apply them to their work.*
