

<i>Interior designer</i>	<i>A person who designs the inside of a space.</i>
<i>Intersection points</i>	<i>Where two lines meet and cross at a point. X</i>
<i>Loom card frame</i>	<i>A frame or card to weave with.</i>
<i>Mood board</i>	<i>A collection of pictures, colours and textures to show your ideas.</i>
<i>Personality</i>	<i>The qualities which make us who we are.</i>
<i>Running stitch</i>	<i>Small hand stitching that looks the same on both sides of the fabric.</i>
<i>Synthetic materials</i>	<i>Man-made materials.</i>
<i>Textile designer</i>	<i>An artist who designs printed, woven, or knitted textiles.</i>
<i>Warp</i>	<i>The threads running from top to bottom.</i>
<i>Wax resist</i>	<i>Drawing with wax then painting over it with paint. The areas covered in wax will not allow the paint to settle.</i>
<i>Weave</i>	<i>To pass threads or strips over and under each other.</i>
<i>Weft</i>	<i>The threads running from side to side.</i>
