







Vocabulary	
2D shapes	Flat shapes - length and width.   
3D shapes	Solid shapes, 3 dimensions - height, length and width.   
Abstract	When the artwork is made from colour, shape and pattern rather than objects which you recognise.
Contemporary	Art work from the time we live in now.
Printing	A design is made on a surface which can then be transferred using ink.
Shade	To add black to a colour to make it darker.

2D shapes are flat. 3D shapes are

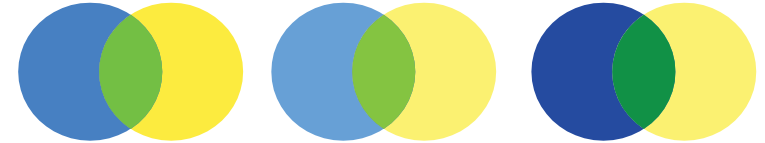
2D Square



3D cube



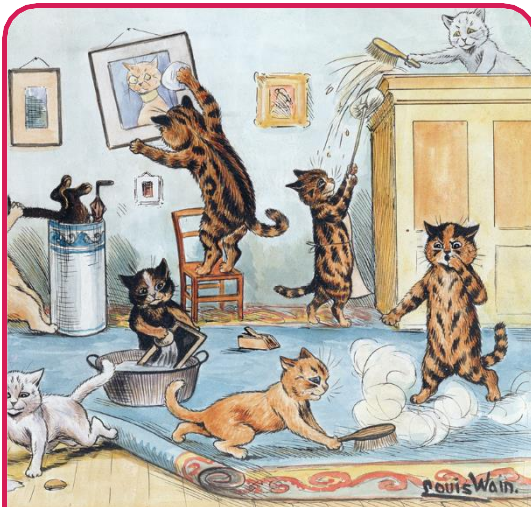
You make different shades of green, by mixing different amounts of yellow and blue together.
