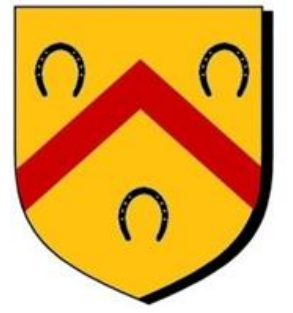




The Pochin School
