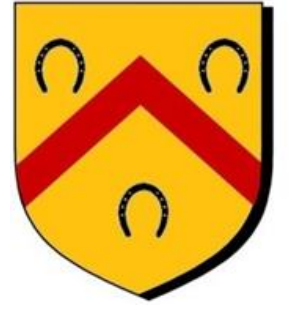




# The Pochin School
