#### Weekly Learning

The children have had lots of fun active learning this week. Preschool and class 1 have taken part in Mindfulness PE sessions, where they have learnt through dance, storytelling and their own emotions. I have very much enjoyed sharing an afternoon in class 4 as they became Roman citizens, many who were also members of the Roman Senate, advisors to the Emperor and the Emperor. They had many real-life scenarios that they had to vote on and the Emperor had to make a final decision. It was fascinating to listen to the children discuss the many aspects of decision making when dealing with building a viaduct, temple to a God, defending their country from attacks up north, or the unruly behaviour of the military in a local market. The Emperor (Rosie) survived well, until she was overthrown by her Senate who did not back many of her decisions.
