What a wonderful first term we have had together! We have all settled in well to Class 1 and can't wait for another half term filled with exciting learning!

In English, we will be looking at poetry about fireworks and recreating our own. Later in the term we will look at a magazine article on how to stay healthy, linked to our science and design & technology. Then we will write our own explanation text on ways that we try to stay healthy. Towards the end of term, we will be writing a letter to send to Father Christmas.

In mathematics, we will continue working on addition and subtraction. Year 1 will also be exploring the properties of 2-D and 3-D shapes, sorting them into groups and making patterns with them. EYFS will continue learning numbers through the engaging Ten Town as well as exploring shape, matching pairs and making repeated patterns.

Our geography topic this term is 'Our Beautiful Country' and this will give us lots of exciting opportunities across the curriculum. We will explore the human and physical features of the UK, as well as, the countries, cities and towns within it.
