It has been a lovely week at school with so much great learning taking place.

Class 1 are creating a lovely winter wonderland display. There are lots of arts and crafts taking place in class for this. There has also been lovely counting, maths and sequencing work taking place which the children are enthusiastic to share with any visitor to the classroom.
