


The Pochin School Newsletter 27th January 2023

STRIKE DAY

The National Education Union (NEU) are due to commence industrial action on Wednesday 1 February 2023.

Based on the latest information we have received from teaching staff, The Pochin School intends to be open to all pupils on this day. However, please be aware if we experience high staff absences on this day, that would affect the safeguarding and well being of children, we may have to close a class at short notice. We will endeavour to give parents as much notice as possible.

The majority of lessons will go ahead as normal on this day. In the event of manageable staff absence, pupils will be supervised and appropriate activities given.

It is worth noting that further industrial action is planned by the NEU on Wednesday 1 March 2023, Wednesday 15 March 2023 and Thursday 16 March 2023. I will update you with any changes to our industrial action response if and when they occur.





Bikeability

We were so pleased to be able to offer the children in Class 5 the opportunity to undertake Level 1 and Level 2 Bikeability training. This teaches children to **Start and stop** with more confidence

Pass stationary vehicles parked on a road

Understand the road: signals, signs and road markings

Negotiate the road: including quiet junctions, crossroads and roundabouts

Share the road with other vehicles

The children learned a huge amount and have grown in confidence significantly. However they haven't yet covered the skills of riding on more complex roads, negotiating more complex roads or responding to unpredictable situations such as when a car pulls out in front of you. The Bikeability instructors, who thoroughly enjoyed working with such a delightful group of learners, wanted parents to know that the children are not yet sufficiently skilled to be cycling on busy roads independently. We know they will all be keen to be on two wheels as much as possible: please help them stay safe!
