Reading at Home with your Child

Just a reminder that all children should be reading 5 times a week at home to a parent/ adult, this should be recorded and shared with the teacher. We understand that many children are competent readers and can read for pleasure at home independently. However, as children read more complex and challenging books/stories, the vocabulary they experience will become more challenging. Through experience, we know that it is during the times parents listen to their children read, and discuss what has been read, that children and parents explore the true meaning of the words within context, extending children's vocabulary. This build back ground knowledge around the topic and a greater depth of **understanding**. As a result, pupils reading ability improves, they gain more pleasure out of reading and generally do better at school as they have a greater general knowledge of the world.

King Charles III Coronation Celebrations

We are all excited about the Coronation of King Charles III. For many people and children this will be the first coronation they will have seen in their lifetime. In celebration the school will be holding special Coronation events on Friday 5th May.
