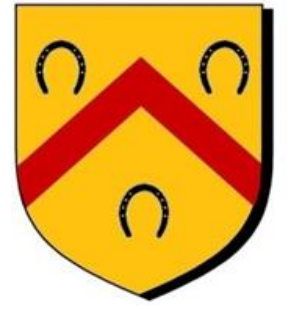


The Pochin School

We hope this newsletter finds you well and that you had a joyful Christmas break. As we kick off the new term, we are excited to share some highlights from our school community this week.

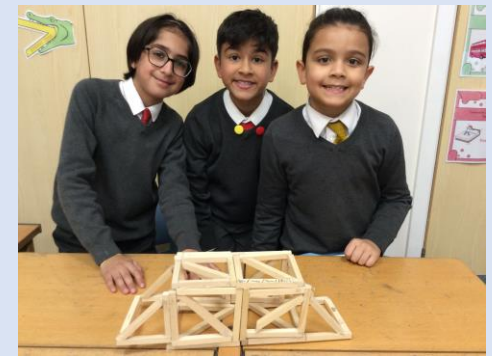
