


The Pochin School Newsletter 2nd February 2024

Action Aid - Homeless donations

Action Homeless would like to personally thank you for your generous contribution over the recent festive season to help support individuals and families experiencing homelessness. Over the Christmas period, Action Homeless were accommodating over 250 people experiencing homelessness. We knew that it would be particularly challenging for many of our residents, who are often separated from their loved ones, and wanted to ensure that they felt connected and supported.

With your help we were able to do this, thank you!

Our festive support began in early December with a "Connections Week", which included a range of activities designed to bring people together from festive baking to Christmas card making and bingo.

Our dedicated teams of corporate volunteers helped pack over 90 gifts bags with treats which had kindly been donated in response to our Wish List appeal. These were handed out on Christmas Day when Christmas dinners were served at a range of projects. One gentleman commented that the gift bag had made him feel special as so many people connected to Action Homeless had thought of him at Christmas.

Our very youngest residents enjoyed a Christmas Party with a special visit from Santa who delivered some lovely gifts.

As well as helping people to enjoy the festivities, we were able to provide additional measures to support people who found themselves in crisis. We opened an extra 5 emergency rooms at our main hostel, Mayfield House, and were able to ensure that people had everything they needed to stay comfortable and warm. Our community lounge, food and hygiene pantry opened to provide essentials to anyone who needed them. We were able to help one lady who was moving into her own property to get all the essentials that she needed to settle into her new home at a time when many other services were closed.

Action Homeless really appreciates the contributions from individuals, businesses and the wider local community during the festive season, and the integral part these contributions played in making sure people experiencing homelessness at Christmas had the chance to feel connected and supported.
