






We have some exciting events planned over the next month, including:



Standard Uniform

- White blouse or shirt
- (for Pre-School children only a white polo shirt).
- House colour tie; red for Windsor, yellow for Charnwood.
 (Pre-School children do not need to wear a tie)
- Grey skirt, pinafore dress or trousers.
- White, grey or black socks.
- Grey or black tights
- Sensible black leather or leather look shoes with low heels (no trainers, fabric shoes, no open sandals). Plain-black flat boots may be worn when there is snow on the ground.
- Grey cardigan or jumper
- Plain, simple head bands and hair accessories in school colours or black



Class Dojo

As a school, we use Class Dojo to record house points and celebrate achievements. You will shortly be receiving log-in details for Class Dojo, which will allow you to access your child's Class Story and stay upto-date with their progress. This means you can get a glimpse into your child's day at school, see what they've been working on, and celebrate their successes along with us.

Homework and Reading Diaries

This year, we will be using a digital reading diary called Boom Reader, which means no more loss of records and will reduce environmental impact of book production.

For homework in Key Stage 2, we would also like to make this online and it will include access to Times Tables Rockstars, Rollama for Grammar, Punctuation and Spelling.
