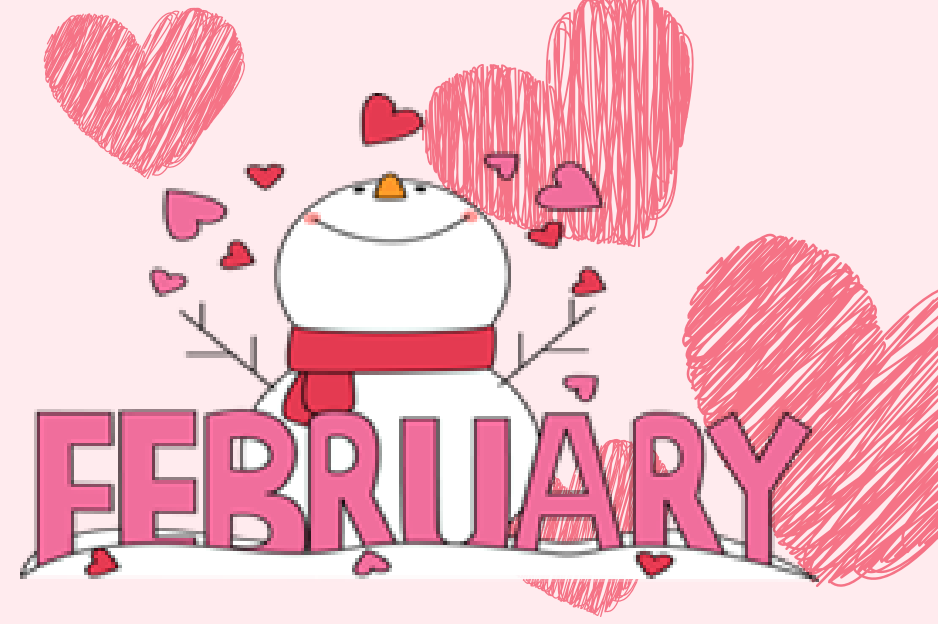


The Pochin School Headteacher Newsletter



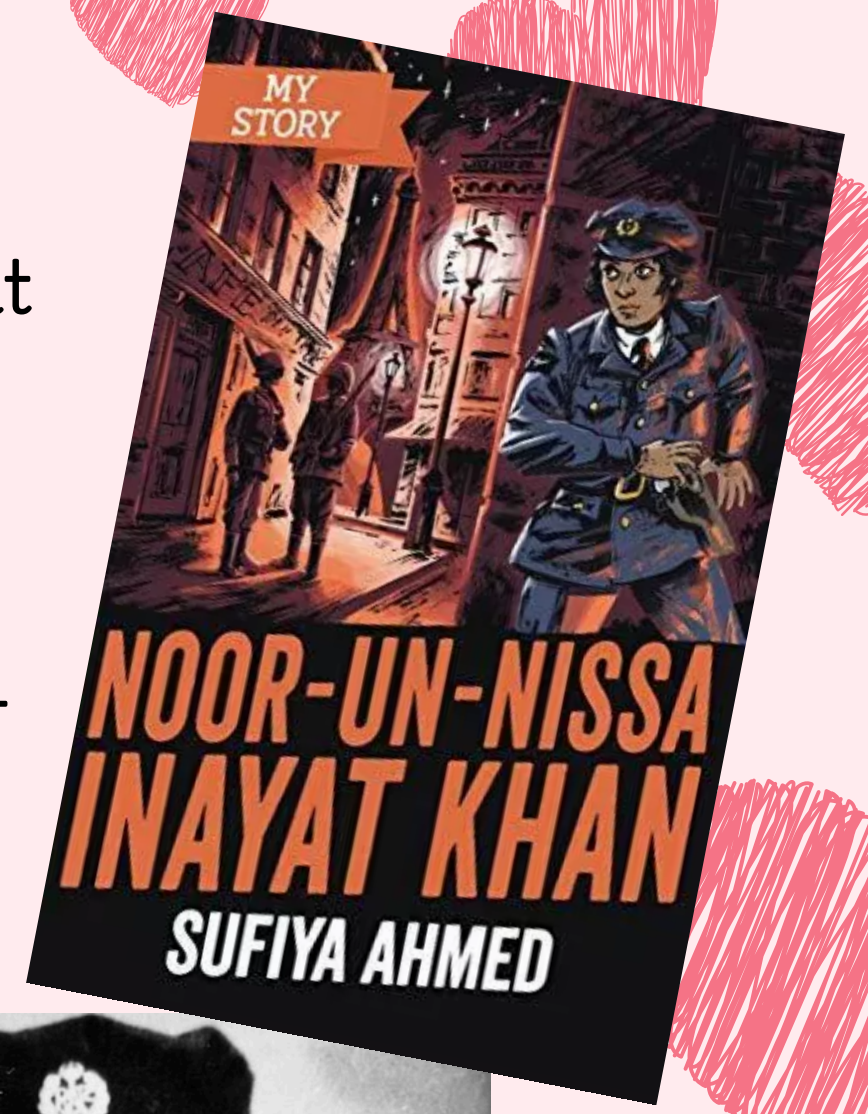
January has been another busy month at The Pochin School with lots of wonderful learning happening in each and every class. Here are some highlights!
