As part of National Science Week, the children in Key Stage 2 took part in a workshop with the lovely Jyoti!



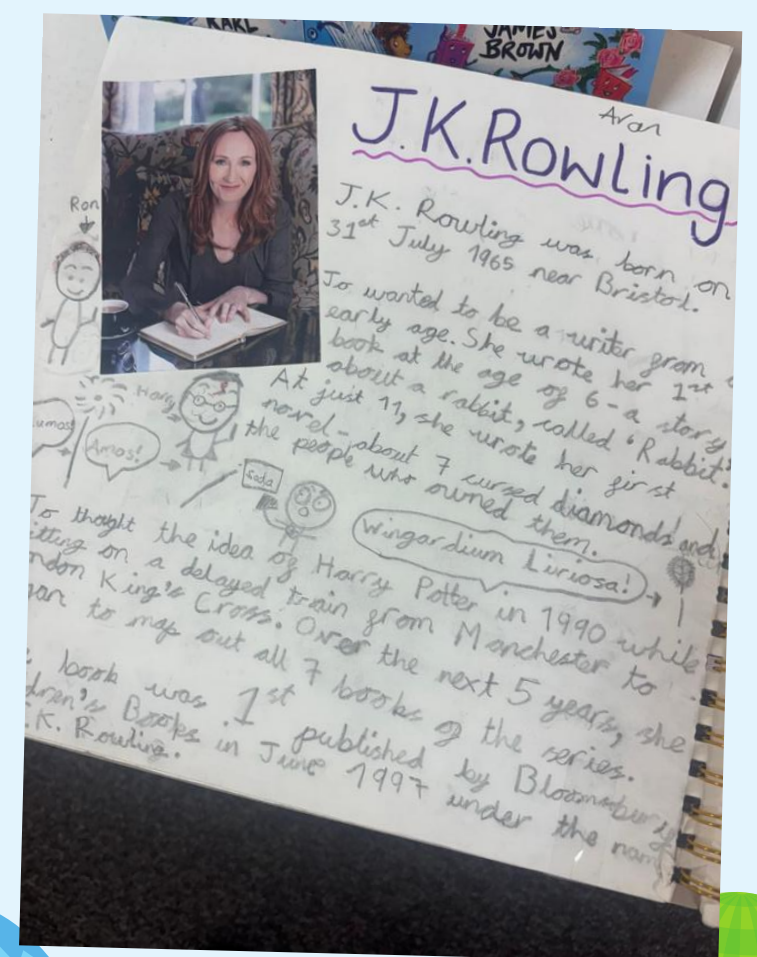
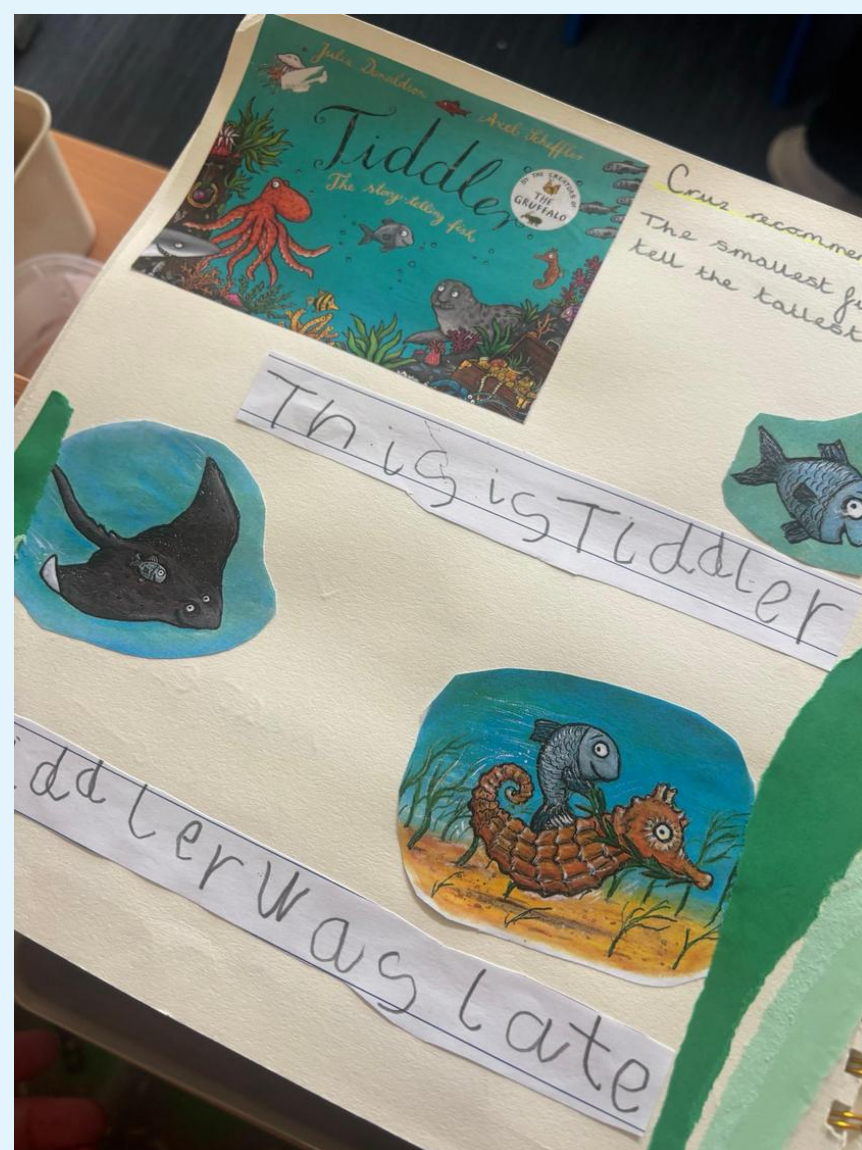
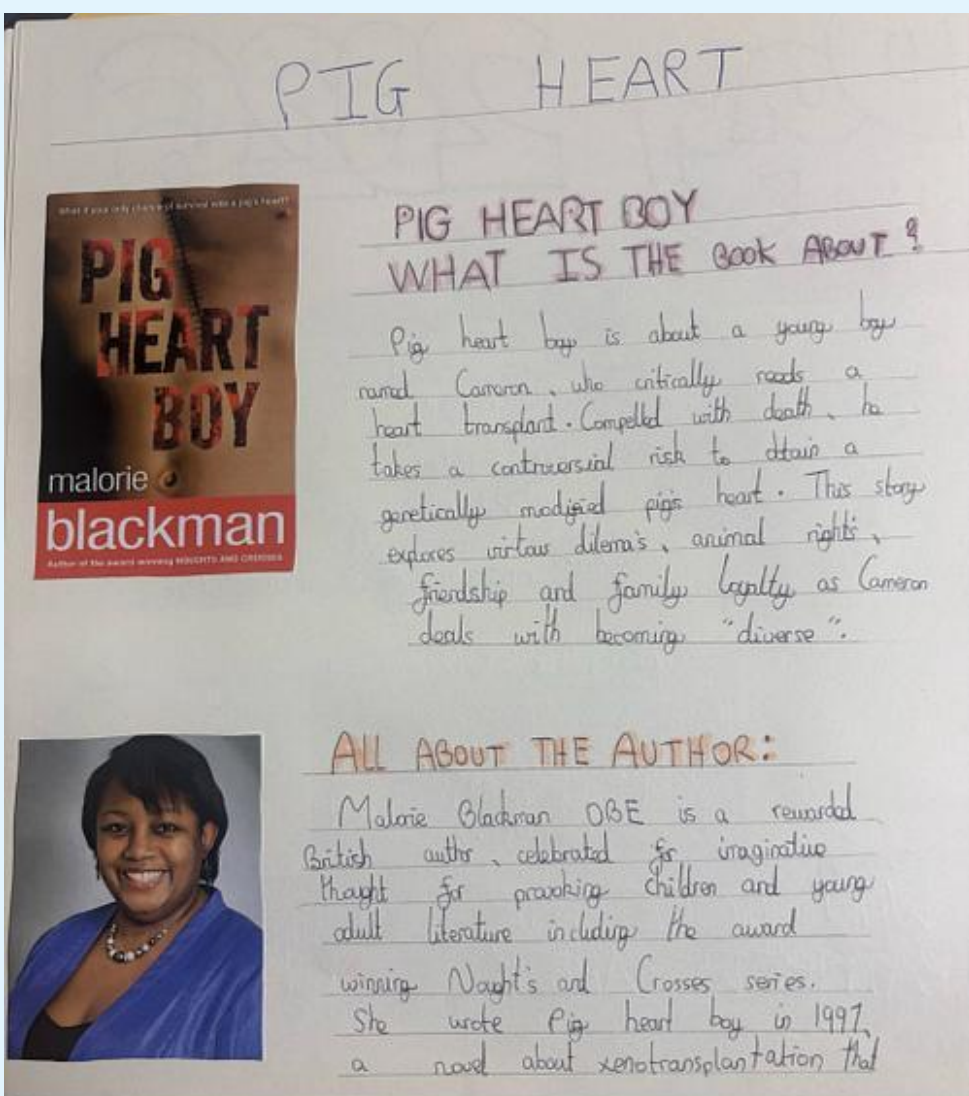
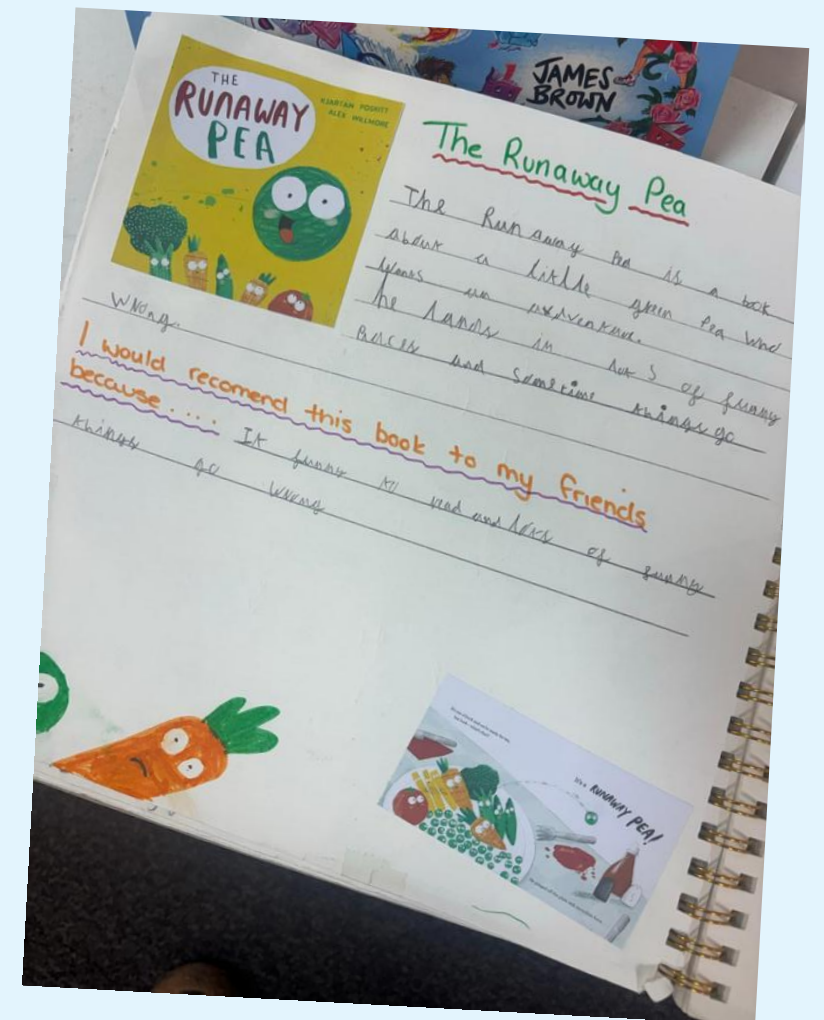
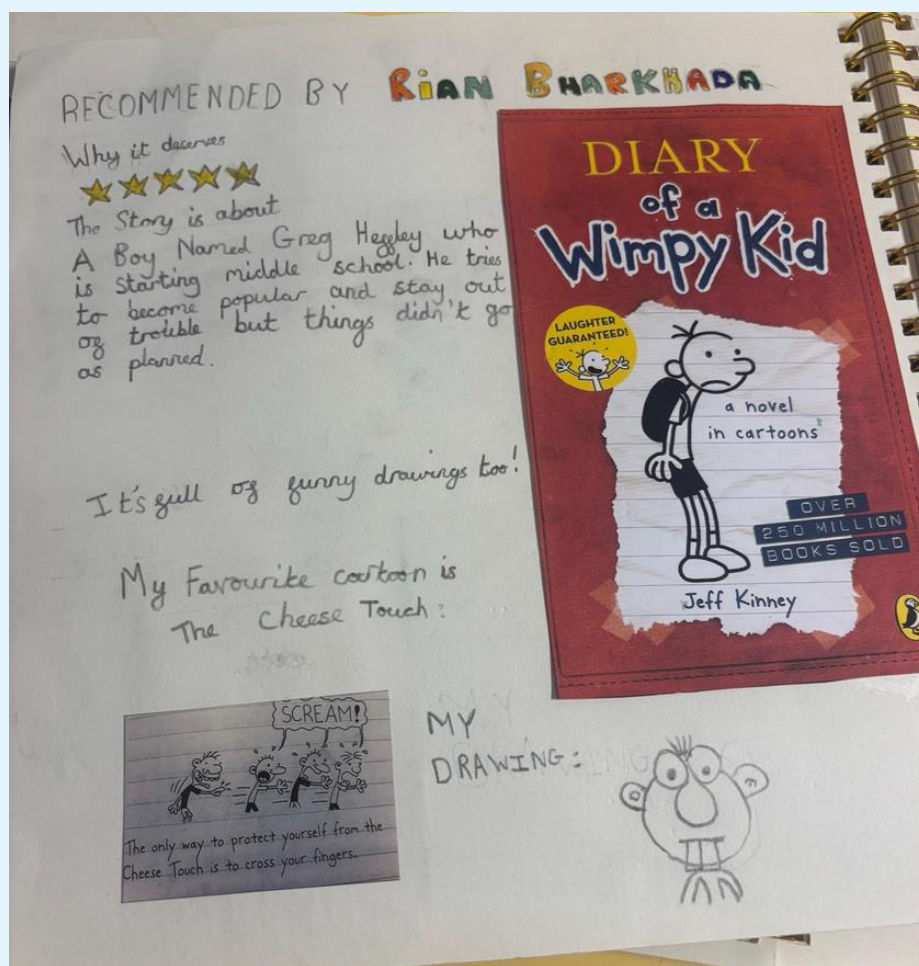
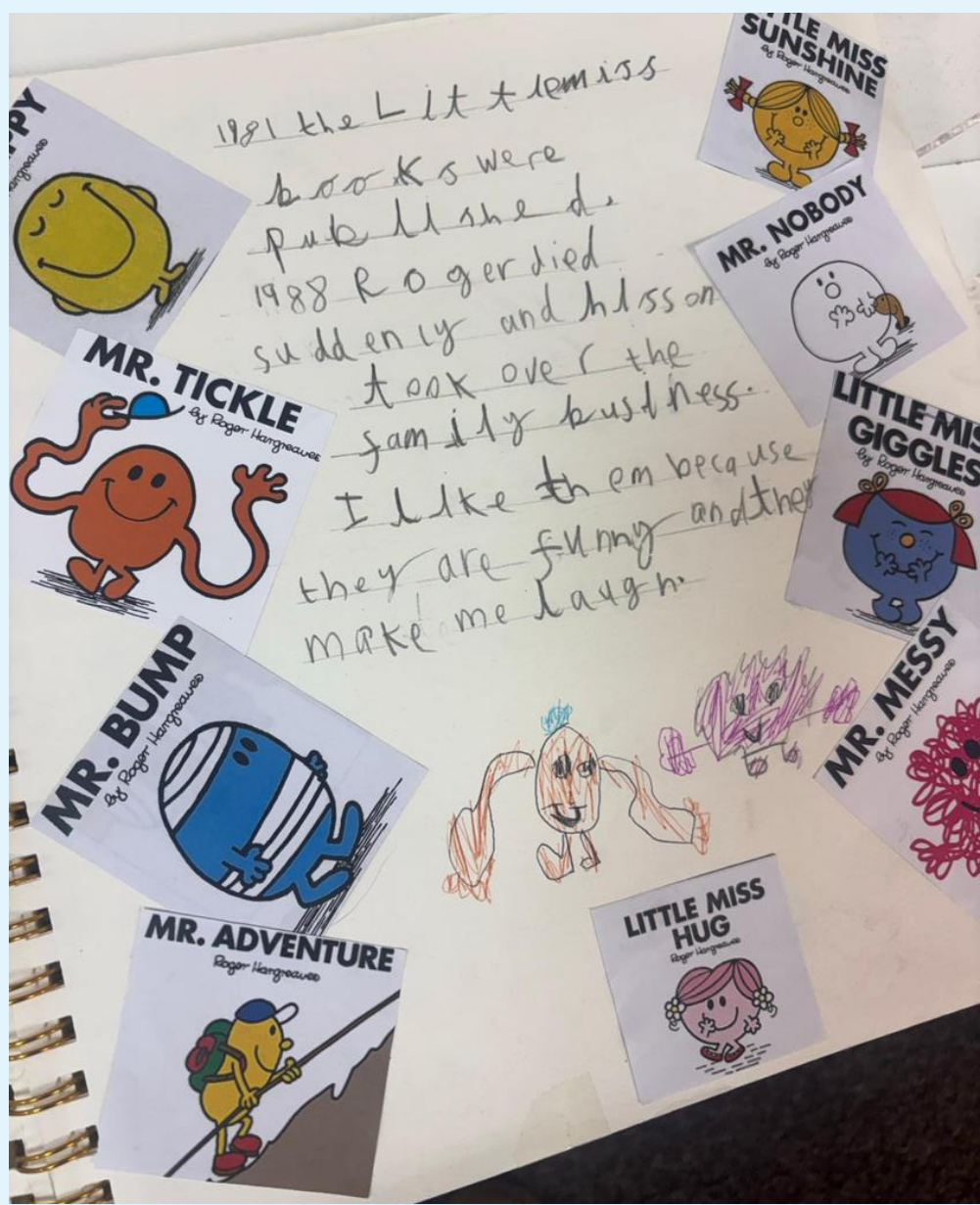
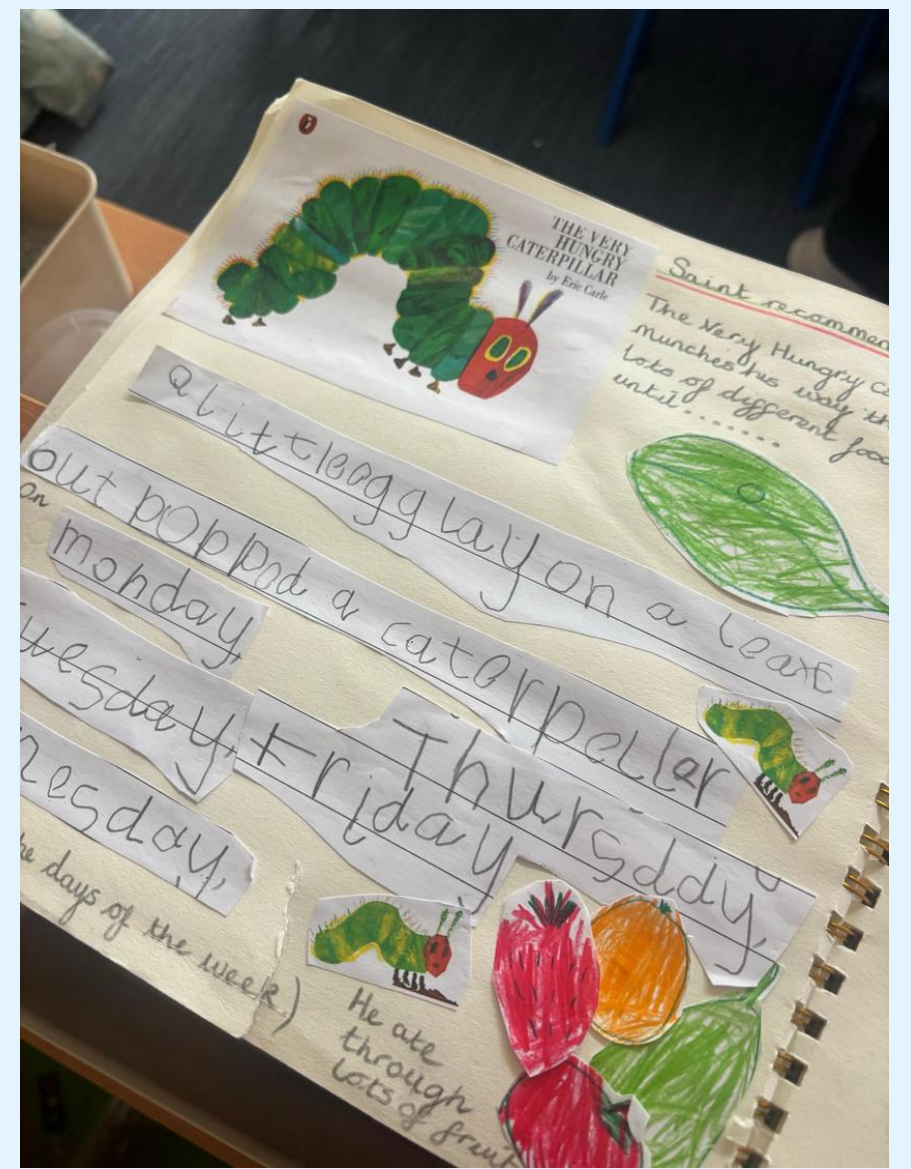
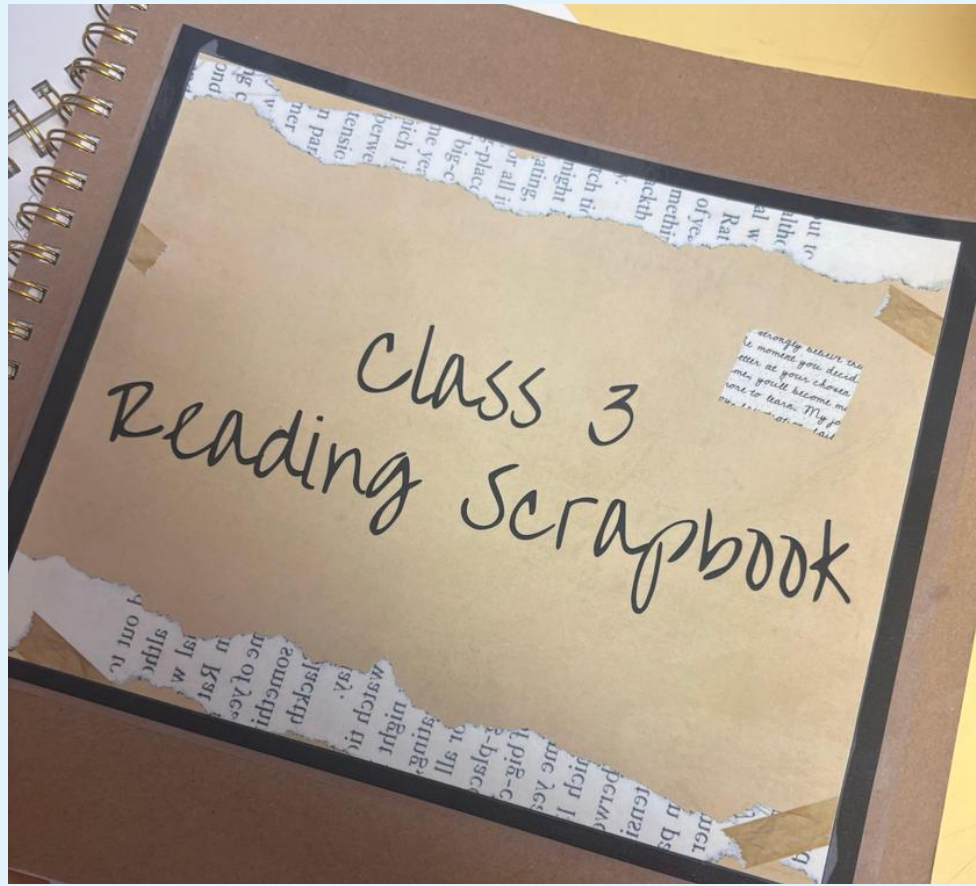
Class 5 have reached 5000 House Points as a class and as a reward got to make pizzas! Delicious!
